DESTINATION INSPECTION MANUAL

GENERAL GOODS

IMPLEMENTATION DATE: 9th February 2026

1. PURPOSE

This manual outlines the requirements for Destination Inspection for goods imported from countries where KEBS has no pre-inspection arrangements.

2. SCOPE

This Manual applies to all goods, excluding motor vehicles, imported from countries in which KEBS has not appointed inspection company(ies) to provide Pre-Export Verification of Conformity (PVoC) services.

4. TERMINOLOGIES

- **KEBS Recognized Laboratory** - is a laboratory with established and demonstrated competence to conduct tests specified in approved Standards. For the purpose of this manual, a KEBS-recognized laboratory includes all laboratories duly accredited to ISO/IEC 17025:2017, NSB Testing Laboratories and Government-designated laboratories.
- **Destination Inspection** - is a conformity assessment process undertaken on imported consignments at the points of entry upon arrival, for the purpose of determining conformity with relevant standards, technical regulations and other applicable requirements.
- **Quality documents** – these are **verified and controlled documents, including** laboratory test reports or certification permits and related technical records issued by a certification body such as NSB, IECEE, etc. **used as objective evidence to demonstrate compliance with applicable standards, technical regulations and conformity assessment requirements.**
- **Approved Warehouse** -
- **Free Sale certificate** - is a certificate issued by an authorized agency demonstrating that the product is freely sold and compliant with the applicable regulatory requirements in the country of origin.

5. INTRODUCTION

The Standards Act under sections 12 (1) and (2) requires that a person who imports shall ensure that every product complies with the Kenya standard and shall not place on the market or put in service any product that is not sold freely or conforms to applicable regulatory requirements in the country of origin. Further, Legal Notice No.78 of 2020 provides for the inspection of imported products either in the country of supply or at the port of entry.

To ensure efficiency in Destination inspection while maintaining compliance of imported products to Kenya standards, importers are required to acquire and furnish their suppliers with the applicable Kenya standard for product testing in KEBS recognized Laboratories prior to importation. All imported products are required to be accompanied by quality documents from recognized certification bodies, recognized laboratories or from recognized National Standards Bodies (NSB) of the respective exporting countries as proof that the products meet the requirements of relevant Kenya Standards or approved specifications.

To facilitate efficient clearance of goods at the Ports of Entry, importers are advised to utilize the existing Pre-Arrival Processing (PAP) framework by submitting their applications and required documents referred to in clause 6 to KEBS through the KENTRADE single window system well in advance for review.

6. CERTIFICATION OPTIONS UNDER DESTINATION INSPECTION

KEBS shall undertake destination inspection, leading to issuance of local CoC, on a risk- based approach as outlined in the four options below.

Where sampling is undertaken, consignments may be released conditionally (at KEBS sole discretion) for safekeeping at the importer's premises pending testing.

An importer whose products have been released conditionally shall swear an affidavit to declare that the product(s) sampled for testing shall not be disposed of in any manner until testing is concluded and the final conformity assessment decision communicated by KEBS.

In general, the following importation documents shall be submitted by the importer for KEBS to commence the destination inspection process: the invoice, the IDF, the packing list, the BL/AWB customs entry, and Free Sale certificate.

6.1 Option 1

This option shall apply to products listed under the Legal Notice No. 78/2020 *Schedule of criteria for exemption of specific products from PVOC requirements (Annex 1)*, except Courier parcels, Products under KEBS Diamond Mark Scheme, and Products manufactured within the East African Community (EAC).

These products shall be cleared based on verification of the documents specified in the schedule of the legal notice (Annex1).

6.2 Option 2

This option applies to products that have demonstrated consistent compliance with applicable quality requirements through certification schemes such as KEBS Diamond Mark of quality, KEBS Product Registration, IECCE CB certification, EAC partner state product certification and any other product

certification scheme administered by an NSB which KEBS has signed an MoU with.

These products shall be processed for release based on document verification, physical inspection and testing shall be undertaken based on the individual scheme's surveillance plan.

In addition to the mandatory importation documents listed in clause 6 above, the importer shall submit the following documents for clearance of goods under this option.

6.3 Option 3

This option applies to courier parcels, products under Ministerial waivers and products that have previously been tested by KEBS and found to consistently comply, provided the KEBS test report is not more than six (6) months old.

These products shall be subjected to document verification and random physical inspection and/ or testing prior to clearance. In addition to the mandatory importation documents listed in clause 6 above, the importer shall submit the following documents for clearance of goods under this option.

6.4 Option 4 (Used Textiles and footwear)

Registration with KEBS is mandatory for all importers of used textiles and footwear. In addition to the mandatory importation documents listed in clause 6 above, these consignments shall be conditionally released based on verification of the documents listed below for physical inspection at the warehouse approved by KEBS at the time of registration.

- Fumigation certificate
- Certificate of registration of the importer

6.5 Option 5

This option applies to consolidated goods imported by KEBS - registered consolidators and other products not covered under the above four options (Clauses 6.1, 6.2, 6.3 and 6.4). These products shall be subjected to mandatory physical inspection and/or testing before release. However, products accompanied with verifiable Laboratory test reports traceable to the imported batch from an ISO/IEC 17025 accredited laboratory are exempted from testing at destination.
